

ILLINOIS CERTIFICATION TESTING SYSTEM

Test Fees for Illinois Certification Tests

Test fees cover all costs associated with test registration, administration, scoring, score reporting, as well as new test development and program enhancements. Enhancements include additional test dates and test sites, faster turn-around on test scores, and Internet registration and score reporting.

The fee for most tests is \$60. In addition to the fee per test, examinees will be assessed a nonrefundable registration processing fee which must be paid once for each test date for which one registers. This processing fee is \$25 per regular test administration and \$30 for the supplemental test administration.

For example, an examinee registering to take only the Basic Skills test at one test administration will be assessed a total fee of \$85 (\$60 for the Basic Skills test plus the \$25 registration processing fee). An examinee registering to take the Basic Skills test and the Elementary/Middle Grades test at one test administration will be assessed a total fee of \$145 (\$60 for the Basic Skills test plus \$60 for the Elementary/Middle Grades test plus \$25 for the registration processing fee).

Fees have been reduced for examinees who must pass the Special Education General Curriculum test and the content test for the special education endorsement area. The test fee for the Special Education General Curriculum test (#163) is \$30, and it is also \$30 for the content test for each of the four entry-level special education certificates: LBSI, #155; Speech-Language Pathologist: Teaching, #153; Teacher of Students Who Are Blind or Visually Impaired, #150; Teacher of Students Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing, #154.
