

Timeline for School Districts for the Internet Safety Contest

- **November 2009** – Districts download documents from Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) website at (http://www.isbe.net/curriculum/html/internet_safety.htm).
- **November 2009 - March 2010**– Teachers present information to the students, students will be working on projects and presentations in schools. **Schools must judge projects by March 1, 2010.** Schools can determine their submission deadline.
- **By March 1, 2010** – The winning projects are to be sent to their district offices for the district wide judging in the respective categories and grade level groups.
- **By March 31, 2010** – Deadline for districts to submit winning projects to ISBE. Districts are to enter no more than one project per category and grade level group with a maximum of eight (8) entries. Only districts may submit. No submissions by schools will be accepted.
- **April 2010** – District entries will be judged. The team will consist of members from ISBE, Attorney General’s Office and the Governor’s Office.
- **May 2010** – Winners will be announced and certificates will be awarded at the ISBE board meeting. Winners will be invited to the meeting.
- **June 2010** – (Internet Safety Month) Winning projects will be posted on all of the participating offices’ websites.
- **November 2010** – Illinois Educators Technology Conference (IETC) – Winners will have the opportunity to present at the conference.
