

## NEWSCAST

### Performance Standard 28D.E

Students will present a 2-3 minute version of a newscast to include three of the following: news, current events, weather and sports. Each student will design a poster to include at least four pictures to be referenced in the report accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: understanding vocabulary and cultural aspects of a newscast;
- *Comprehension*: respond appropriately to cues; and
- *Communication*: effectively communicate ideas in the target language.

### Procedures

1. ***In order to use the target language to present information, concepts and ideas for a variety of purposes to different audiences***, students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
  - Present a simple age- and state-appropriate report on a familiar topic; and
  - Use known vocabulary and grammatical structures to write and present a simple production or media presentation.
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. The teacher should have taught common vocabulary related to school, weather, and sports.
4. Students will present a 2-3 minute version of a newscast to include three of the following: news, current events, weather and sports.
5. Each student will design a poster to include at least four pictures to be referenced in the report
6. Evaluate each student's work using the Foreign Language Rubric as follows and add the scores to determine the performance level:
  - *Knowledge*: understood key aspects of a newscast.
  - *Comprehension*: responded effectively to written and spoken cues.
  - *Communication*: used appropriate skills to communicate effectively in the target language.
