

WHAT'S THE CONNECTION?

Performance Standard 28A.F

Demonstrate understanding of a segment of a familiar video in the target language and note characteristics and relationships of the characters/objects on a graphic organizer accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: know the main points of the selected video;
- *Comprehension*: respond to cues with understanding; and
- *Communication*: use appropriate skills to communicate in the target language.

Procedures

1. *In order to understand oral communication in the target language (28A)*, students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
 - Demonstrate understanding of short, simple narratives, conversations, or aural presentations with assistance from resources within developmentally appropriate, highly predictable, and familiar context.
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Give students a graphic organizer with the main characters/objects in selected video as a guideline for students.
4. Show the video segment once to familiarize students with the characters and action of the clip.
5. Have students watch the segment a second time and fill in characteristics and relationships of the characters/objects on the graphic organizer.
6. Evaluate each student's work using the Foreign Language Rubric as follows and add the scores to determine the performance level:
 - *Knowledge*: knew key details of video.
 - *Comprehension*: understood necessary vocabulary and context.
 - *Communication*: effectively conveyed key characteristics and relationships in the target language.

Examples of Student Work not available

Time Requirements

- One to two minutes to read the prepared organizer
- 25 minutes for showing the segment twice and completion of the graphic organizer

Resources

- A video clip in the target language and a graphic organizer with characters/objects from the video segment
- For purposes of the field test, the title and portion of the video clip used along with the answer key used should be reported with the results
