1. About Anna District #37
 - A. Rural Community – Southern Illinois
 - B. Student Population (K-8) – 680 students
 - C. Poverty Rate – 51% free and reduced lunches
 - D. Mobility Rate – 22%

2. A Quick History (3 Components of our plan)
 - A. Reading Room (K-2) – developed in 1990
 - 1) Anna Plan – 3 tiered reading instruction/intervention plan
 - a) Tier 1 – whole class instruction in classrooms
 - b) Tier 2 – whole class / small group instruction at individual levels in Reading Room
 - c) Tier 3 – pull out interventions
 - 2) Tier 2 and 3 based on Dibbles, DRA, and Running Record assessments

 - B. Student Support Team – Implemented in 1994
 - 1) Master Schedule – allow common planning time for all grade level teachers
 - 2) Identification of “at-risk” students
 - 3) Development of interventions
 - 4) Parent contact

 - C. Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) – implemented in 2000
 - 1) 3 Tiered behavioral intervention plan
 - a) Universal – all students
 - b) Secondary – Small group(s) of students
 - c) Tertiary – Individual students

3. Response To Intervention – A merger of the 3 models
