Definition: “Jointly administered CTE program” means a program or set of programs within a nonpublic school located in Illinois, as determined by the State Board of Education pursuant to Section 7.5 of this Act.

“Technical academy” means a nonpublic school located in Illinois that: (1) registers with the Board pursuant to Section 2-3.25 of the School Code; and (2) operates or will operate a jointly administered CTE program as the primary focus of the school. To maintain its status as a technical academy, the nonpublic school must obtain recognition from the Board pursuant to Section 2-3.25o of the School Code within two calendar years of its registration with the Board.
